ZERO BURNING POLICY

For our oil palm estate and palm oil mill operation activities and programme, we follow zero burning practices and commits to comply all applicable legislation as per the Malaysian Environment Quality Act (EQA) 1974, the Natural Resources and Environment Ordinance (NREO), 1958 and the Natural Resources and Environment (Fire Danger Rating System) Order, 2004.

There shall be no open burning of any kind except where deemed necessary with the prior approval of the relevant authorities. This includes domestic waste, agricultural waste, biomass or by products generated by the estates and palm oil mills.

Estate and milling operations shall provide training to its workers on fire prevention and techniques to put out fire. We shall also communicate to our contractors and smallholders on this Policy.

An action shall be taken against any party who is found to be in non-compliance to this Policy, including termination of business contract, dismissal from job, or handover to local authorities, where applicable.

The policy shall be updated as and when necessary.
